### SPECIAL PERMIT FOR MEDIA ACTIVITIES

Hereafter referred to as the Permittee, is permitted to conduct media activities within Baxter State Park as specified below and in the attached documents as referenced below during the period July 20-23, 2015 inclusive.

The Permittee has permission to conduct still and video photography activities within the boundaries of property administered by the Baxter State Park Authority and has agreed to conform in all respects to the requirements specified in this **MEDIA PERMIT In accordance with the BAXTER STATE PARK MEDIA POLICY**, the Permittee agrees to:


1. The Permittee agrees to comply with the Rules and Regulations of Baxter State Park (attached), including any and all trail closure, hiking and camping limitations imposed by Baxter State Park in the normal conduct of Park operations and the provision for public safety.
2. Permittee is responsible for obtaining any necessary campsite, cabin or bunkhouse lodging necessary through the regular camping reservation process at Baxter State Park. Baxter State Park provides no special provisions for lodging within the Park or assurances of available lodging through the Park reservation system.
3. The Permittee shall secure release forms from any and all Park users identifiable in filming activities and provide Baxter State Park with copies of the release forms prior to August 15, 2015.
4. Permittee group includes and is limited to the following personnel:
  - Darryl Czuchra, Producer
  - David Conover, Director (207.236.2078)
  - David Wright, Director of Photography
  - Assistant Camera (TBD prior to entry to Baxter State Park)
  - All persons in the permittee group must be fully identified to the Park Director prior to arrival at Baxter State Park. Additions, subtractions and changes in the permittee group must be identified to the Park Director prior to arrival at Baxter State Park.

5. Permittee is required to comply with all camping facility occupancy limits for any sites reserved in Baxter State Park.
6. During the filming and the conduct of any media activities under this permit, the Permittee shall take any actions necessary to avoid the interference, disturbance or obstruction with the use of the Park by other Park visitors. The Permittee shall not block or interfere with hiker passage on trails or on mountain peaks permitted for media activities under this permit.
7. The use of video equipment for filming in any way or fashion is prohibited within 500' of Baxter Peak.
8. Filming within 1000' of Chimney Pond Campground shall be limited to two (2) persons and one (1) hand-held or tripod-mounted camera.
9. The use of lighting instruments, light screen(s), boom(s) props, actors or talent are prohibited under this permit.
10. The use of tripods for video or still photography is prohibited above treeline under this permit.
11. The use, contracting, application of aerial filming utilizing helicopters or fixed wing aircraft is prohibited under this permit.
12. The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (drones) is prohibited in Baxter State Park.
13. This permit is limited to a maximum of two (4) days within the period beginning and ending July 20-23, 2015.
14. Media Permitfee schedule: Permit Fee Waived.

a. Permitted project 1-2 consecutive days	\$60
b. Permitted project 3-5 consecutive days	\$100
c. Permitted project more than 5 consecutive days	\$20


**Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this permit shall result in the immediate eviction of the Permittee and associates from Baxter State Park.**
